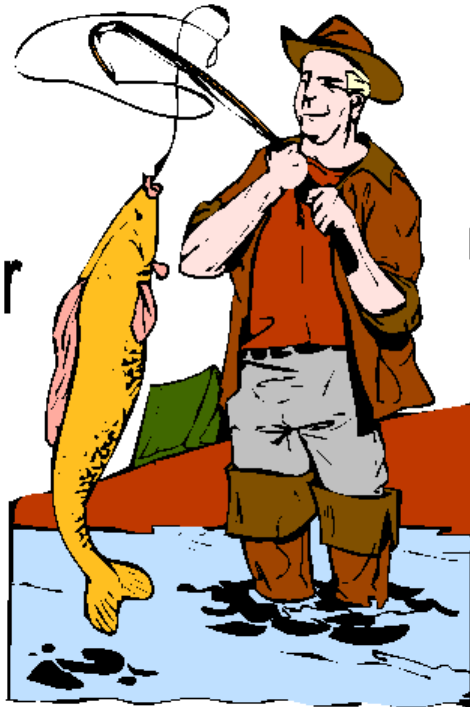
Elections are coming up with nominations at the May meeting. A nomination committee will be set up in April to approach if you are interested (and I hope we have members interested) in putting their foot

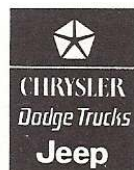
